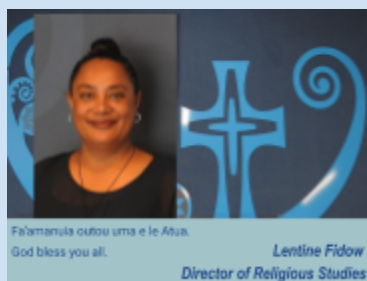

This week we have our School/Parish Mass - Vigil Mass on Saturday 22nd of June at 5.30pm.

**The Mass falls on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ.**

**The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ is celebrated on the second Sunday after Pentecost which marks our return to Ordinary Time. At one time, this day was called Corpus Christi, Latin for "the Body of Christ." This day commemorates the sacrament of Holy Communion in our Catholic Church.**

At the last Supper Jesus knew he was going to leave his friends. So he turned the bread into His Body and the wine into His Blood-even though they still looked like bread and wine-and told the Apostles to do the same. Jesus gave the power to the Apostles to change the bread and wine into His Body and Blood in the Mass. Now when we gather at Mass, we believe that, through the power of God, the bread and wine that we share at Communion become the Body and Blood of Jesus, who gives Himself to each of us in a very special way.

**We encourage you and your families to join us as a community in the celebration of this special Mass on Saturday.**

  2. To coach swimmers to increase distances achieved in each stroke.
  3. To instruct and train adults in swim teaching and coaching.
- Children are graded as to their level of experience by our coaching staff and allocated to the group of their current swimming ability.
